MAKING TYNESIDE HOME



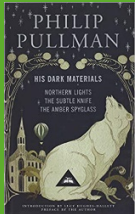

THE SHRINE OF ST. CUTHBERT – DURHAM CATHEDRAL



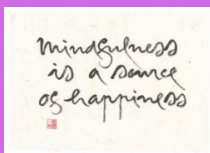
